On 26 November, on the Invitation of the Irish Baroque Orchestra and in partnership with Ardee Baroque Festival and the National Concert Hall, REMA strikes up a conversation between promoters, ensembles, and education organisations, to work on the structuration of the sector at the national level, mobilize and connect all its actors in the field of performance, research, concert promotion and education, during a full day of panels, workshops, networking and music.


